

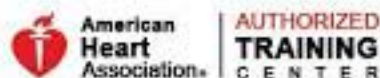


Basic Life Support BLS for Health Care Provider

- 1 A video-based, instructor-led course that teaches both single-rescuer and team basic life support.
- 1 Trains participants to promptly recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give high-quality chest compressions, deliver appropriate ventilations and provide early use of an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED).
