<p>“How can I talk to my Health?” “ 19/10/2022</p>	<p>On October 13, 2022, an off-campus activity was conducted at Elementary School 32 in Al Hofuf to raise awareness about healthy diets among children. The students actively participated in the activity, which included the development of learning materials and games. The goal was to engage the audience in a fun and interactive way while providing them with important information about healthy eating habits.</p> <p>Target population: Elementary School 32 in Al Hofuf students. No of Participants: 8 students from KSAU-HS and two classes from Elementary School 32 in Al Hofuf. Overall evaluation of the event: 4.75/5</p>
<p>World Diabetes Day 2022 08/11/2022</p>	<p>On November 08, 2022, an off-campus activity was conducted by students in Al Hofuf, specifically in the Al-Ahsa Municipality, to raise awareness about diabetic diets and BMI calculations for the public. The activity focused on diabetes management and complications, with the students actively participating in the development of learning materials for the audience. The Clinical Nutrition department actively participated in the event, and several teams from different programs at KSAU-HS were selected to compete. Our team, consisting of the best academic students from the 3rd and 4th year, received second place overall. The coordinator of the Clinical Nutrition department provided training to the team in preparation for the competition.</p> <p>Target population: CAMS students, faculty members, and staff. No of Participants: 3 students from Clinical Nutrition Department KSAU-HS. (3rd + 4th-year students). Overall evaluation of the event: 4.74/5</p>
<p align="center">Neurohealth 2023 with Occupational Therapy Department 15/03/2023</p>	<p>On March 15, 2023, KSAU-HS hosted a male campus activity in the open area focusing on <u>neurohealth</u> from various perspectives, including diseases, behavioral therapy, and occupational therapy. The event aimed to increase knowledge and awareness of the role of occupational therapy and clinical nutrition in treating neurological conditions among KSAU-HS students in Al-Ahsa. It also aimed to promote the idea of a multidisciplinary team collaborating with OT to treat neurological conditions. Additionally, clinical nutrition students discussed sports nutrition during the event.</p> <p>Target population: CAMS students, interns, faculty members, and staff. No of Participants: 23 students from Clinical Nutrition Department KSAU-HS. (3rd + 4th-year students) + 4 students from the OT department. Overall evaluation of the event: 4.80/5</p>
<p align="center">Career Day 2023 20/03/2023</p>	<p>On March 20, 2023, KSAU-HS held a male campus activity in the open area to assist students and interns with the recruitment process in Saudi Arabia's governmental and private sectors. The university invited several hospitals and companies to help students choose their career paths. In this regard, the Clinical Nutrition department also participated in the event by inviting hospitals and private markets to present the roles and responsibilities of clinical dietitians.</p> <p>Target population: CAMS students, interns, faculty members, and staff. No of Participants: 3 students from Clinical Nutrition Department KSAU-HS. (3rd + 4th-year students). Overall evaluation of the event: 4.75/5</p>
<p align="center">World Kidney Day 2023 30/05/2023</p>	<p>On May 30, 2023, KSAU-HS hosted a female campus activity in the open area to raise awareness about chronic kidney disease (CKD) as a community initiative. Hypertension, a global public health problem, is the leading contributor to the global disease burden and a major modifiable risk factor for heart disease, stroke, and kidney failure. CKD is a frequent cause of hypertension, and uncontrolled hypertension can lead to CKD. During the event, the students educated the audience about proper dietary interventions for CKD. The department also invited the college deans to attend the activity.</p> <p>Target population: CAMS students, interns, faculty members, and staff. No of Participants: All the 4th-year students in the Clinical Nutrition Department. (41 total attendance). Overall evaluation of the event: 4.75/5</p>

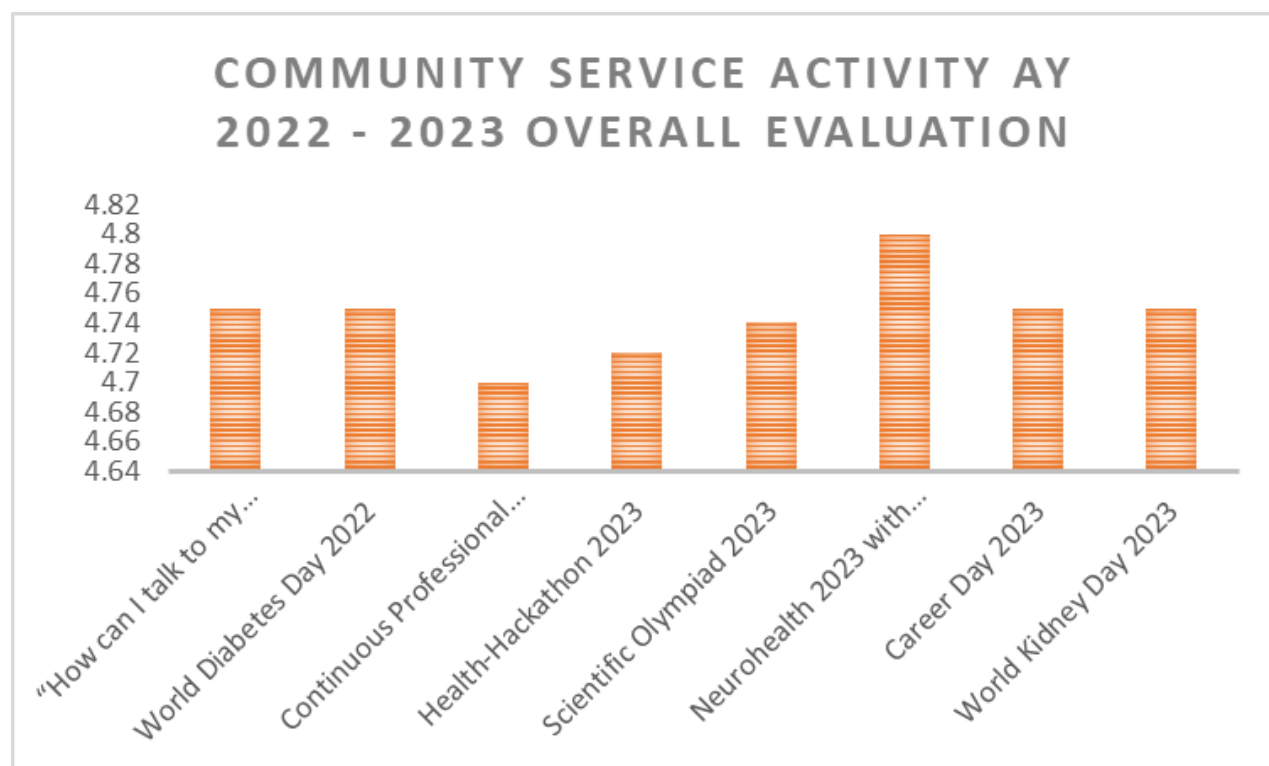
