<p>Follow placement schedule according to the established Phase II pathway approved by the CON and the concerned Division of Nursing Services.</p> <p>Attend one day orientation to phase II.</p> <p>Attend mandatory workshops.</p> <p>Attend unit orientation.</p> <p>Receive training on the followings:</p> <p>Safety Reporting System (SRS)</p> <p>Professionalism.</p> <p>Communication utilizing SBAR techniques</p> <p>CCRT activation</p> <p>Code blue response.</p> <p>Customer friendly services &amp; patient centered care.</p> <p>Patient safety culture and International Patient Safety Goals.</p> <p>Environmental safety.</p> <p>End of life care</p>	<p>Complete pathway specific workshops, if deemed necessary to area of assignment,. An example of these workshops is conscious sedation workshop and ECG workshop. (the decision of joining pathway specific workshop need to be jointly reviewed and approved by the CON and the concerned Division of Nursing Services)</p> <p>Consolidate previously acquired clinical competencies.</p> <p>Complete all relevant specific unit competencies in the area of assignment.</p> <p>Develop knowledge background relevant to area of specialization or area of employment</p> <p>Achieve the placement specific learning outcomes</p> <p>Provide supervised total nursing care to a full load of patients in area of assignment leading to independent practice.</p> <p>Exercise patient advocacy.</p> <p>Conduct self professionally.</p> <p>Demonstrate competence in electronic documentation.</p> <p>Demonstrate competence in communication with the interdisciplinary team members, patients and families.</p> <p>Demonstrate effective team playing skills.</p> <p>Present 2 in-services (one cultural &amp; one clinical)</p> <p>Attend the unit meetings.</p> <p>Participate in the unit based quality &amp; safety related teams and projects.</p> <p>Demonstrate effective time management skills.</p> <p>Exercise clinical leadership and act as a charge nurse for at least 5 shifts</p> <p>Understand the role of the RN in relation to patient education, patient discharge processes, preventing medication errors &amp; patient safety.</p> <p>Comply with the rotation attendance requirements.</p>	<p>Complete end of rotation evaluation of clinical experience.</p> <p>Complete BSN Program Exit Survey and participate in the CON assessment activities</p> <p>Achieves a satisfactory end of rotation evaluation.</p> <p>Complete NGHA (or the placement site) &amp; KSAU-HS clearances.</p> <p>Prepare CV</p> <p>Prepare your application for recruitment</p> <p>Prepare application for Saudi Council.</p>
