Policy title:

COMPENSATION OF STUDENTS WHO PUBLISHED IN JOURNALS WITH IMPACT FACTOR ≥ 3.00

PURPOSE:

To enhance students' publications.

JOURNALS SPECIFICATION:

Only journals accepted for promotion of faculty by the University Scientific Council at KSAU-HS will be accepted for this award.

APPLICABILITY:

This policy applies to papers published in 2023 and later.

COMPENSATION:

1- Papers published in journals with impact factor 3-3.99	3000 SAR
2- Papers published in journals with impact factor 4-4.99	4000 SAR
3- Papers published in journals with impact factor 5-5.99	5000 SAR
4- Papers published in journals with impact factor 6-6.99	6000 SAR
5- Papers published in journals with impact factor 7-7.99	7000 SAR
6- Papers published in journals with impact factor 8-8.99	8000 SAR
7- Papers published in journals with impact factor 9-9.99	9000 SAR
8- Papers published in journals with impact factor ≥ 10.00	10,000 SAR

PROCEDURE:

- 1- The student(s) must submit with evidence a memo to SRB requesting the award. The evidence must include the published paper (not letter of acceptance) and evidence of the journal's impact factor.
- 2- If there is more than one student on the paper, the memo must include all their names.

- 3- An official memo from SRB through Office of Research, Assistant Vice-President Educational Affairs, Vice President Educational Affairs addressed to H.E. The University President.
- 4- The submitted work must have been published within the last 6 months. Claims after 6 months of publishing date might not be accepted.
- 5- The proposed reward will be divided equally between the authors (students), if more than one.
